

2. Given the increasing significance of environment-related responsibilities in the E&P sector — including the implementation of the Site Restoration Guidelines, facilitation of statutory clearances, and the emerging domain of Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage (CCUS) — it is crucial to ensure capable leadership within DGH's Environment and Clearances Division.

3. In this context, the position of Additional Director General (Environment & Clearances) in DGH, traditionally held by a senior Indian Forest Service (IFoS) officer at Level 14, has remained vacant since the repatriation of the previous incumbent in May 2022.
