Subject: List of candidates of IFS Exam, 2024 who have been granted extension of one year to join the Indian Forest Service-regarding.


Sir/Madam,

It may be noted that in view of proviso below Rule 3(3) of Indian Forest Service (Regulation of Seniority) Rules, 1997, they will be assigned the subsequent year i.e. 2026 of the year of allotment instead of 2025, as already stated in clause Para 6 of offer of appointment. It may also be noted that further extension/relaxation of time may not be granted.
