**Inviting Bids for supply of microwaves under GEF-UNIDO-MOEFCC project on
"Environmentally Sound Management Of Medical Waste In India".**

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, is the nodal agency for the project on Environmentally Sound Management of Medical Waste in India being implemented in five states namely Gujarat, Karnataka, Maharashtra, Punjab and Odisha.

2. The overall objective of the project is to reduce and eliminate the releases of unintentionally produced persistent organic pollutants (UP-POPs) and other globally harmful pollutants into the environment through proper management of biomedical waste generated from the Health Care Facilities in India. The project will promote the country-wide adoption of best available techniques/best environmental practices (BAT/BEP) in the Healthcare Facilities of widely differing in their complexity and size as well as evolving medical waste management infrastructure and industry in a manner that protects human health and reduces adverse environmental impacts.

3. The project major deliverables include promotion of non-incineration technologies for pre-treatment of medical wastes as BEP. To fulfil the objectives, Capacity Building of the 04 large HCFs in each of the five participating states is to be done by supply of microwaves.
