With reference to the above mentioned subject and letter it is submitted that the Steering Committee of the State CAMPA in its meeting dt.9-06-2010 had approved APO for Rs.14.27 crore for Compensatory Afforestation works for the year 2010-11 as detailed in Annexure-1. A copy of minutes of the said meeting is enclosed herewith.

In the same meeting APO for Rs. 28.60 crore for NPV projects works for the year 2010-11 were approved as detailed in Annexure-2.

A fresh NPV project "Creating Green Corridor near Bahucharaji" has been approved by the Steering Committee with APO for Rs. 0.54 crore.

NPV project for construction of alternative road in lieu of the existing public road passing through the Valavadar Black Buck National Park was examined by the Steering Committee and Sanctioned amount of Rs. 1.63 crore now enhanced to Rs. 1.99 crore as per plan estimate with APO of Rs. 0.37 crore for the year 2010-11 was approved.

Thus total APO's of Rs. 43.78 crore have been approved by the Steering Committee in its Meeting dt.9-06-2010 for the year 2010-11. Therefore, in view of the above, it is requested to kindly release the funds totaling Rs.43.78 crore from CAMPA at the earliest so as to enable the Department to complete works in time.
