About Organisation

The School had a modest beginning in 1942 as the Department of Architecture of Delhi Polytechnic. In 1955, a full fledged School of Town Planning came into existence. Later it was integrated with the Delhi Polytechnic in 1959. Beginning of the eighties the Government of India through the Ministry of Education and Culture conferred on the School the status of *'Deemed to be a University'* on recognition of the emergence of the School as a premier institution of National Importance. The School is a specialized university, only one of its kind, which exclusively provides training and education at various levels in planning, design and management of different aspects of human habitat and environment. The School has taken lead in introducing several academic programmes in various inter-related specialized fields at Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral levels, some of which are not available elsewhere in India.





Activities of the Centre


The ENVIS Center on Human Settlements is located in the Center for Environmental Studies at the School of Planning and Architecture, New Delhi. The main activities of the center are


Services
