Strict economy should be observed so as to keep the actual expenditure to the minimum. The works are to be executed as per the Sanctioned Schedule of Rates applicable in the area. X.

The expenditure is to be incurred as per the allocation of funds. There shall be no diversion of earmarked funds from one item to another one except in case of unavoidable circumstances xi. and only with the prior approval of MoEF&CC. If the implementing agency does not use the fund for the purpose for which it was given, it has to refund the same with interest.

There should not be any overlapping of activities under the scheme with the activities of xii.

The programme is to be monitored by State regularly and the quarterly progress report shall be submitted by the State on the progress of implementation of the scheme in format xiii. given in Annexure - VII of the Operational Guidelines of the Scheme, for every quarter of the
