Evidence of deposit of TDS/GST in case of contract payments and CST in case of purchase of leviable goods are obtained along with Utilization Certificate and compliance viii. of DBT scheme has to be ensured.

The UCs (as prescribed in GFR-19A), Progress Report along with satellite photographs of physical deliverables with date and latitude-longitude coordinates before and after ix. implementation shall be submitted in time.

Strict economy should be observed so as to keep the actual expenditure to the minimum. The works are to be executed as per the Sanctioned Schedule of Rates applicable in the х.

The expenditure is to be incurred as per the allocation of funds. There shall be no diversion of earmarked funds from one item to another one except in case of χi. unavoidable circumstances and only with the prior approval of MoEF&CC. If the implementing agency does not use the fund for the purpose for which it was given, it has to refund the same with interest.

There should not be any overlapping of activities under the scheme with the activities of xii.


