The following are the main activities of the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate change during the month of the

National Clean Air Programme (NCAP)

A 'Sensitization-cum-Review Workshop' was organized on May 21-22 in Chennal, Tamil Nadu, with participation of State Government officials / officials from Municipal Authorities, from the southern region. During the sessions, the current status of the NCAP was discussed. It was highlighted that the air quality improvement efforts have shown positive trends in achievement of better air quality in 94 cities across the country whereas 35 cities have shown deterioration and there is no change in 3. The initiatives of Tamil Nadu Government like 'ECOmmute' were appreciated, while best practices of Trichy, Nalgonda, etc were shared for wider replication.

International Biodiversity Day

Various events were organised on the occasion of the International Day on Biological Diversity (IDB) on May 22, 2022. The there of IDB 2022 was "Building a shared future for all life". On this occasion, a biodiversity exhibition on the theme "Biodiversity, Nutritional Security and Human Well-being" was organised in Chennal where State Biodiversity Boards, ZSI, BSI, etc showcased their activities for conservation, protection and management of biodiversity. Prizes were given to the winners of 3 National Level Competitions organised by NBA to create awareness about environment protection and blodiversity conservation. A "Special Cover" of India Post was also released.

There was a Workshop in which detailed interactions were held with the representatives of State Biodiversity Boards, UT Biodiversity Councils, Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs), and the Business sector wherein use of funds by Riodiversity Management Committees, Capacity Building of BMCs and Inclusion of Blodiversity Conservation under CSR activities were discussed.

Workshop on Conservation and Wise-Use of Wetlands

A National Workshop for Developing a Roadmap for Participatory Conservation and Wise-Use of Wetlands was organised on May 21, 2022, at the National Center for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM) in Chennal, Tamil Nadu. The workshop was attended by over150 participants which included wetlands managers from 75 wetlands of international and national importance, representatives from State and UT Wetland Authorities, Corporates, Wetland champions from different States, NGOs, Knowledge Partners and Experts.





Roundables were held on building convergence and orealing participatory governance mechanisms for bridging the Science-policy action drivide. Experiences were where by Wetland Champions who work at the grassroot levels and they were felicitated for their exemplary work. An MoU was also signed believen the McEFCC and CII for participation of Corporation in the conservation of wellands.

Environment, CRZ Clearance and Forest Clearances

During the month, diversion of 647,1599 ha. of forest land in 94 cases, was approved (in-principle) under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1990, 178,887 ha. of non-forest land and 562 2004 ha. of degraded forest land was esamissized and approved for carrying out Compensatory Afforestion. Further, 39 projects were accorded Environmental Charamone (EC) CRC Clearance.

Five ESZ Notifications involving 05 Protected Ansas have been issued by the Ministry during the month of May. Out of these, 05 Notifications, 03 cent Notification, 11 respect of the Protected Ansas of Kannarang Tiger Reserved (Aurent Notification Plandesh), Kuron Interpolated Park (Madrolly Plandesh) and Koundrijna Wildlife Sanchaury Plandesh), Kuron Aber (All Park (Madrolly Plandesh) and Koundrijna Wildlife Sanchaury (Plandesh) and Notifications have been insuced in respect of the Protected Ansas of Kibber and North Ministrations have been insuced in respect of the Protected Ansas of Kibber and North Ministration have been supported to the North Ministration have been supported by Ministration and Plandesh) and Gulmang Wildlife Sanchaury (UT of Jammu & Kashmiri).

Further, several notifications/clarifications were issued with regard to streamlining of Environment Clearances:

- Permissibility of Gas based power plants in Island Protection Zone (IPZ) and Island Coastal Regulation Zone (ICRZ).
- Special dispensation for 50% expansion in coal mining projects, within the existing premises/mine leases area, without additional land acquisition.
- Amendment in provisions related to public hearing.
 Non-applicability of the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 for manufacturing and utilization of Polyurethane Foam.
