The following are the main activities of the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change during the month

Elimination of single use plastic

- (i) MoEPCC organized an event in CPCB where an Awareness Masc2 Prelotif was launched on April 5, 2022. Hortic Minister, EPSCC was the Chief Guset. Securitary Orinfring Water and Sartistary and Secretify (Perchapting Haij) also persicipated and assured convergence with their outreach and advocacy activities. During the event, other green Intelletes for plastic waste management were also launched, v.c. National Deathboard on Elimination of Single Use Plastic, Edended Producer Responsibility Portal for Plastic Packaging; and Hobile App for Orienton Relatessial.
- (i) On this occasion, the GLB Part Institute for Himsteys Studies aligned as MoU with regard to their patient for Industrial Production of Caraphera from Waster Plastic. The Technology has been developed by Kumanu University, Nainital under the research project funded by National Mission on Himsteys Studies, and has been Icensed to Mik. Heorop Industries Pvt. Ltd., Nainital through the National Research Development Corporation (RNDC), New Orbit. This technology is for industrial-scale production of Caraphera from waster plastics and would encourage more industries to come Sorward for conventing plastic waste info multistillier oxiduals.
- (iii) Further, seven (7) Winners of the India Plastic Challenge-Hacksthon 2021 were felicitated for their digital solutions for plastic westernitigation and elimination of Single-Use Plastic. An exhibition of Innovative models developed by Start-Upe was also organised on the occasion.

Reforms

Major systemic reforms have been understann by the Ministry in the last few months for the common of the common of the common of the common process. An amay as 6 notifications and Otike were issued in the month of Agri, regarding proposed examplicions from environment clearance, expansion of manufacturing/mining excludes upto as administration of the common of



blocks, etc. A meeting was conducted with all the SEIAAs on April 29, 2022 to sensitise them regarding the said reforms and about the recent delegation of powers, and also to review the functioning of SEIAAs.

Convergence with Scientific Ministries

A meeting was held with the Secretaries of Departments of Science & Technology, Earth Sciences and DG-CSIR for discussing training and capacity building of scientists trough DSIR; convergence of activities with DST or taping the bis-devenity potential of the country, and synapsign research findings of the Ministry of Earth Sciences with oceastal conservation procrammes of MoRFCOC.

Forestry related activities

- (i) During the month, diversion of 1790.109179 ha. of forest land in 121 cases was approved under Forest (Consensation) Act, 1990. Further, 514.4888 ha. of non-forest land and 2106.22996 ha.of degraded forest land have been earmarked and approved for carrying out Compensationy Afforestation.
- (ii) The Ministry, vide letter No. 5-17/2020-SU dated April 20, 2022 has recommended to DGFT to amend the export policy and allow export of bamboo charcoal.
- (iii) In view of the close linkages of agroforcestry with the activities and mandate of the Ministry of Ernironment, Forest and Climate Change, a note with respect to transferring the subject of Agroforcestry from the Department of Agroculture and Farment Welfare to MoEFOC; has been moved on Agr 112, 2002, for Intel[®] Ministerial Consultation.
