G20 Matters A prepayatory meeting for G20 was held on August 17, by the G20 Sherog, with all line Ministries. I presented the thomes that have been finalised for the Environment

I participated in the 3rd EDM-CSWG meeting, under the Indonesian Presidency. on August 29-30 in Ball, Indonesia. The focal themes being taken up by India in the G20 next year were presented by me in the Troika Session. Battery Waste Management Rules 2022

The Ministry notified the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022 on August 22 which aims to ensure environmentally sound management of waste batteries. These rules have been finalized after extensive stakeholder consultations, and cover all types of hallaries. viz. The provisions apply to the entire value chain comprising producers, dealers, entities involved in collection segregation, transportation, refurbishment and recycling of waste batteries.
