G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Directorate of the Forest Education, Dehradun and its Constituent Academies and College (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2015, relating to the post of Laboratory Assistant, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Laboratory Assistant in the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Directorate of Forest Education, Dehradun and its constituent academies, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Directorate of Forest Education, Dehradun and its Constituent Academies (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application. - The rules shall apply to posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix. - The number of the post, its classification and level in pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification. - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax. - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.

7. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

<p>Promotion Laboratory Attendant with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in in Level-1 (Rs.19900-63200) who possess a matriculation certificate from a recognized Board or equivalent, subject to passing a test to be prescribed by a Principal of concerned Central Academy/Coimbatore/Burnihat or Central Academy of Forest Education, Kurseong.</p> <p>Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.</p> <p>Note 2: For the purposes of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.</p>	<p>Group 'C' Departmental Promotion Committee (for considering promotion) consisting of: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
